10 reasons to take a winter holiday in the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn

In the Alps, there are many beautiful places, family-friendly ski resorts and especially in the Austrian Alps, great food. Still, it is only cool in the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn. What makes the Skicircus so unique?

1. The long name

For those who are not already familiar with the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn, the first thing you will grin about is the long name. However, just as long as the name is, are the list of opportunities in the ski region. The area, which covers two Austrian states, combines 270 kilometres of piste, 70 modern lifts as well as three regions.

2. 3 resorts – 2 states – 1 common denominator

Saalbach Hinterglemm is the liveliest place in the Skicircus. Two town centres with pedestrian zones invite you to take a casual stroll around. Almost every accommodation is located near to a ski lift or alongside the piste. Saalfelden Leogang impresses with its wide range of sporting activities. For those who want a winter holiday without skiing, but a Nordic experience, these family friendly towns are perfect. Just over the border from Salzburger Land, to neighbouring Tyrol, the Skicircus opens to the sporty, friendly town of Fieberbrunn. A wide range of activities awaits families and adventure-seekers in this versatile winter paradise. At the same time, the snow-covered peaks attract freeriders who make their own tracks in the powder snow.

3. 408 kilometres of piste and 121 lifts

With the Ski ALPIN CARD – the combination ticket with the Schmittenhöhe in Zell am See and the Kitzsteinhorn Kaprun – in addition to the extensive skiing area of the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn, you can enjoy stunning views of the Zeller See and fill your lungs with Alpine air on the glacier. A car is not required to enjoy the Skicircus experience. By skiing the Viehhofen piste (168, Zone I), you will reach the valley station of the zellamseeXpress which takes you up to the Schmittenhöhe and back down again.

4. Pleasurable moments in powder snow

When you experience skiing in its most pristine form, taking your first turns early in the morning, gliding over virgin snow, your happy hormones will reach a peak. In the Skicircus these moments are only a gondola ride away, as many routes are not too far away from ultra-modern lifts. Freeriders, who want to earn their turns, can hike to the coolest backcountry spots. Extensive deep-snow slopes and exposed flanks attract even the world's elite to the Freeride World Tour in Fieberbrunn every year.

5. A paradise for children

Who doesn't like to reminisce about a family holiday in the mountains and the first successful turns in the snow, and the happy faces when after the first descent from the mountain top to the valley? In the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn, little ones and mini carvers are introduced in a playful way to the art of skiing with dedicated ski schools. Funslopes, snow trails and family parks provide variety on the slopes, where children forget the day's exertions with feelings of joy. Attractive family packages round off a carefree holiday in the mountains.

6. Alpine lifestyle – the finest mountain cuisine

What is part of a successful day on the slopes? As well as divine panoramic mountain views, a swift ascent to the summit and perfect pistes. The stopover! There are no shortages for stopovers in the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn. Whether it is a rustic 300-year-old Alpine hut, a traditionally furnished cabin, or an exclusive mountain restaurant with the finest cuisine. With a choice of over 60 places to stop for refreshments on the mountains, there is something to suit every taste. If you are searching for peace and quiet and would like to lay back in the sunshine on a deckchair after a hearty lunch, you will find what you are looking for, as will ambitious sports enthusiasts who want to charge their batteries in order to make the most of the day on the piste.

7. Walking in a winter wonderland

Whether with or without snowshoes: winter hiking in Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn is an incredibly relaxing experience. On 140 km of winter hiking trails, you can explore the winter landscape on both the mountain and down in the valley while taking in all that the surrounding nature offers. Far away from the lifts, you will find peace and calm. If you would like a day off from skiing, you can still meet up with family and friends for lunch at a mountain hut which can be reached by walking along a sunny hiking trail.

8. A sporty holiday – Nordic winter

The Skicircus is a diverse winter sports region. The Nordic Park at lake Ritzensee in Saalfelden Leogang is a perfect starting point for all Nordic sports enthusiasts. Here, even the youngest children learn the basics of cross-country skiing in the Fun & Snow Park. Cross-country skiers will find everything their heart desires. On the natural ice-rink, you can demonstrate your skills as an ice-skating princess or prince. A cross-country skiing holiday in Fieberbrunn, which is also known as the “snow hole” of the Kitzbüheler Alps, results in a top-class sport and nature experience. Fieberbrunn impresses with its perfectly prepared network of cross-country trails with routes of varying difficulty. Whether classic, beginner or professional, here every cross-country skier will find something to suit his/her tastes.

9. The largest ski circuit in the Alps – The Challenge

“Ski your limit” is the slogan that describes one of the most demanding ski circuits of the winter. The statistics speak for themselves: 65 kilometres of downhill runs, 32 lifts, 12,400 metres of altitude difference. The ski circuit in the “Home of Lässig” can be managed by sporty skiers in around 7 hours (breaks not included). Challenge accepted?

With these distances, “The Challenge” ranks at the top of the list of renowned ski circuits in the Alps and even outshines the “Sellaronda”, the “White Ring” or the “King’s Tour”. This challenging ski circuit in the Skicircus will lead you through one of the most versatile and extensive ski areas in Austria. The focus of this challenge is on sporting performance. A lengthy stopover in one of the numerous mountain huts along the route, admiring panoramic views, or taking the chance to sunbathe should be postponed for the next day of skiing. A total of 32 lifts will need to be taken between Saalbach Hinterglemm, Leogang and Fieberbrunn on this ski marathon.

10. Numerous activities aside from the piste

Casual hikers and romantics alike will find lovely snowshoe trails located in a winter wonderland in the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn. Cosy horse-drawn sleigh rides, a walk over the Golden Gate Bridge of the Alps and a tree-top walk or a hike with Lamas, turn the winter adventure aside from the piste into a dreamlike experience straight out of a fairy-tale.

High-flyers dare to reach top speeds of up to 130 km/h with the Flying Fox XXL - one of the fastest and longest steel zip lines in the world - and view the Alps from above.

Families and toboggan fans can look forward to five different runs with different attributes. After a successful day skiing, take a ride on Timok’s Alpine Coaster which is located at Streuböden mid-station in Fieberbrunn (included in a valid ski pass).

New in Winter 2023/24

A5 Limberg 8er in Saalbach

After 29 years and over 15 million guests, the Limberg 4-seater is being retired and will be replaced by a modern 8-seater chairlift.

The Home of Lässig continues to invest in renewable energy and CO₂ reduction

In total, Austria's mountain railways are the country's second largest provider of electric mobility. The energy required for this comes 100% from renewable energy sources in the vast majority of regions. In order to be able to use this sustainable form of energy in the future, the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn is increasingly relying on its own production of electricity from water, solar and wind power.

This year, in addition to the existing photovoltaic systems, the largest photovoltaic system in the ski area - on the façade of the new Limberg 8er valley station - will be put into operation. In addition, new types of wind turbines are to be installed at the top station, so that in future a large part of the energy needed to operate the new lift can be generated by the resort itself.

In Hinterglemm, the Wiesermühle hydroelectric power plant, which is also being built by the mountain railways, is nearing completion. With a projected annual energy output of 1,800,000 kilowatt-hours (1.8 GWh) - equivalent to the average annual energy demand of over 400 households - this plant is a real game-changer and will make a significant contribution to the self-production of renewable energy for the operation of the cable car facilities in the future.

But the focus is also on the most environmentally friendly operation of the piste equipment, work machines and team buses. For example, the Skicircus is now increasingly using "bio fuel" (HVO100 regenerative fuel), which is made from 100 per cent renewable raw materials. This fuel is not only intended to gradually replace fossil fuels in the ski area, but also reduces CO₂ emissions by up to 90%. Leogang in particular is the first mountain railway in Austria to rely entirely on this "plant power" and thus plays a pioneering role in the industry.

For years, the mountain railway companies in the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn have been investing in ecological, economic and social sustainability and will continue to do so in the future. Topics such as energy efficiency, environmental protection, renewable energy and regional management are consistently advanced.

Timoks Expedition in Fieberbrunn

The new Fun Line "Timok's Expedition" promises lots of fun & adventure for the whole family on slope 104 at the F6 Zillstättlift in Fieberbrunn. Timok - the little explorer-checker - awaits you on his expedition ride with, among other things, rapid snow waves & curves, a tunnel passage and a speed measurement. Let yourself be surprised!

Learn to Ski: Free ski instructors for school groups in Saalbach Hinterglemm

During selected promotional periods, ski instructors for beginners will be provided free of charge as part of school ski courses in cooperation with the Saalbach Hinterglemm Tourism Board and Ski Austria as well as the Salzburger Land Tourism GmbH. The desired number of ski instructors can be requested through the youth guesthouses up to one month before arrival, so teachers do not have to worry about anything else. This should help to anchor skiing in the minds of the pupils as a positive experience and thus train the skiers of tomorrow.

Audi FIS Ski World Cup Finals 2024

16 to 24 March 2024

The World Cup final will be the perfect "final test" for the World Championships!

In March 2024, the crowning finale of the Audi FIS Ski World Cup will take place in Saalbach. The eagerly awaited season finale is also the dress rehearsal for the FIS Alpine Ski World Championships Saalbach 2025.

Before the World Championships come to Saalbach in February 2025, Saalbach is looking forward to welcoming the best ski racers in the world to the World Cup finals of the 2023/24 season in Salzburger Land. This is when the last sporting decisions will be made in both the women's and men's overall World Cup and in the individual discipline rankings. Traditionally, only the 25 best athletes in the respective discipline rankings and all skiers with more than 500 points in the overall rankings are eligible to compete in the season finale. In addition, the reigning junior world champions will be able to present themselves on the big stage of skiing at the finals.

This gives the athletes the opportunity to get to know the World Cup pistes on the Zwölferkogel better and to ski them at race pace for the first time. The World Cup final should also provide the World Cup organising team with important insights into the infrastructure, mobility concept and sports logistics, as World Cup medals will once again be awarded in Glemmtal just eleven months later.

Arrival by Ski

Within the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn, guests can easily get to the World Cup finals directly by ski. Guests can therefore stay overnight in Leogang and Fieberbrunn in a very relaxed way. The pistes on the Zwölferkogel are also accessible during the races, so with the ski ticket you can get right up to the safety fences of the race courses and enjoy the World Cup races in the front row foot-free during a day of skiing.

FIS Alpine World Ski Championships 2025

4 to 16 February 2025

34 years after the unforgettable sunny World Championships in 1991, another atmospheric winter fairy tale will be written in Salzburger Land from 4 to 16 February 2025. In order to be able to present themselves as the perfect host in two years' time, preparations are already in full swing in one of the largest and most innovative tourism destinations in the Alps.

One mountain – all competitions

The focus is on the concept of "one mountain - all competitions". All races will be held on the Zwölferkogel in Hinterglemm, which unites all World Championship slopes with only one finish area for all disciplines. Eleven medal decisions will be held on the Zwölferkogel. That's why Saalbach 2025 will also be the World Championships of short distances. Everything surrounding the races will take place in the centre of Hinterglemm, so all the important locations are within walking distance.

In addition, public skiing will be possible throughout the events. Within the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn, guests will be able to ski directly to the FIS Alpine World Ski Championships 2025. Guests can also stay overnight in Leogang and Fieberbrunn. The ski ticket takes you right up to the safety fences of the race tracks and during a day of skiing you can enjoy the World Cup races in the front row.

Sustainability

The FIS Alpine World Ski Championships 2025 in Saalbach aim to be a green benchmark for future sporting events. The sustainability goals are to be achieved with short distances, good accessibility of all "event hotspots" on foot, all competitions on one mountain and a modern mountain railway and piste infrastructure. Furthermore, optimal travel options by public transport are planned and also the possible sporty journey on skis to the races in Salzburger Land - with free entry along the race course - is unique and corresponds to a green event. REDUCE, RE-USE and RECYCLE are keywords for the entire structural measures.

Tickets for the FIS Alpine World Ski Championships 2025 will be available from March 2024.

The L1+L2 Asitzbahn and L3+L4 Steinbergbahn, from mid-January the B1+B2 12er KOGEL Bahn, B3 12er Express, C1 Hochalmbahn, C3 Hochalm 6er, D1 Reiterkogelbahn, D2 Hasenauer 8er and F1 Streubödenbahn and from March the H1+H2 Kohlmaisbahn already start at 8:00 am.

First Line Fieberbrunn:

Every Wednesday from the end of December, the skiing fun at Bergbahnen Fieberbrunn starts at 7:30 am for an exclusive, small group of 30 people. Accompanied by local guides, you can make your first turns on the untracked slopes and then enjoy breakfast on the mountain.

Ski huts:

There are more than 60 cosy ski huts dotted throughout the entire ski region, inviting guests to take a break and recharge their batteries or quench their thirst, as well as having a chance to take in the views and enjoy the sunshine.

Ski bus:

You can use the ski bus with your ski ticket within Saalbach Hinterglemm, Viehhofen, Leogang, Fieberbrunn, Zell am See and Kaprun with no additional costs. As well as the connections: Saalbach Hinterglemm - Viehhofen, Fieberbrunn - Leogang, Leogang - Saalfelden and Zell am See - Kaprun. There is no ski bus connection between Saalbach Hinterglemm and Leogang, between Saalbach Hinterglemm and Fieberbrunn as well as between Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn and Zell am See-Kaprun.

Ski bus shuttle Skicircus - Schmitten:

The connection from the Schmittenhöhe to the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn is easy thanks to a well-developed ski bus shuttle system and the 680 bus line from the valley station of the zellamseeXpress in Viehhofen to the I1+I2 Schönleitenbahn in Saalbach. Buses depart every ten to twenty minutes. Near the I4 Polten 8-seater chairlift the slope 168 towards Viehhofen connects the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn to the valley station of the zellamseeXpress.

Treetop trail, tennis, ice-skating, private toboggan runs, curling, horse drawn sleigh rides, snowshoe walks, winter hiking trials, lama-trekking, ice carting, quadbike course, archery and more...
