Depending on your tee shot, golfers must cross the Saalach up to six times. During your round, enjoy breathtaking views of the mountain giants of the Steinernes Meer plateau and the Leoganger Steinberge mountain range. This is Alpine golf at its very finest. For all dog owners, the golf club offers another major bonus: four-legged friends may be taken along on the course as long as they remain on the leash. The large, partially covered driving range also features a 6-hole short course for beginners. At the golf course you might also meet local Head Pro John Seymour, who is one of the top 50 golf professionals in Europe and gives private lessons for beginners and professionals.

In case of bad weather, passionate golfers can take advantage of the Indoor Golf Performance Centre at Gut Brandlhof hotel. This state-of-the-art indoor golf simulation facility is open 365 days a year. After an exhilarating golf match, reward yourself with local specialities at the "Einkehr" club restaurant or round off the day in the first-class wellness area of the 4-star superior Gut Brandlhof hotel.

Urslautal Golf Club - featuring a spacious driving range with breathtaking mountain scenery

The Urslautal golf course is located on a high plateau between Saalfelden and Maria Alm. The holes are rich in variety: some are longer than others and some are hilly, though never too steep. With a total surface area of 5,000 square metres and boasting 60 tees, this golf club also features one of Austria's best driving ranges. The 360-degree mountain panorama, which includes the massif of the Steinernes Meer plateau, is also quite impressive. For beginners and advanced players, there are also three practice holes and two golf academies. The Urslautal Golf Academy and the Systema Golf Academy offer golf taster courses, private and group lessons (to achieve Platzreife certification), as well as lessons for the whole family. During an exciting round of golf, you'll need to negotiate more than just 18 holes. Roughs, water hazards, biotopes and bunkers present a real challenge! An unobstructed view makes putting easier. Probably the best view of the Steinernes Meer plateau can be enjoyed from the terrace of the "Remise" golf restaurant, which awaits golfers at the end of the round.
